Each of the new tenants starts with 100 square feet of space, which breaks down to \$75 a month (starting). The Foundry is currently looking for entrepreneurs that are involved with small batch manufacturing and product related services. The new space availability couldn't have come at a better time, as The Foundry has been dealing with a waiting list of businesses looking to set up shop.

"The Service Collaborative, through our YouthBuild program, were happy to partner with The Foundry in this project and are looking forward to future opportunities to collaborate," said Kate Sarata, Executive Director of TSC.

"We had YouthBuild participants enjoying their time at The Foundry so much during training that they now volunteer there on the weekends as a way to pick up other skills. 


